

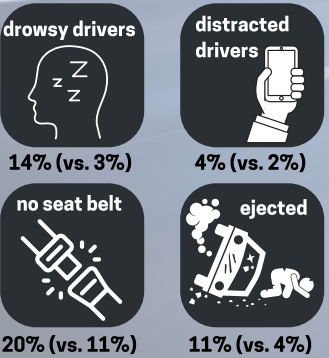

NV Trauma Hospital Outcomes for Motor Vehicle Occupants Injured on 55+ MPH Roads

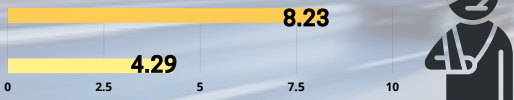

Speed was a major contributing factor to 1/3 of all traffic deaths in Nevada (2014-2018)

Occupant behaviors & outcomes from crashes on roads with 70+ MPH speed limits (vs. 55-65 MPH)

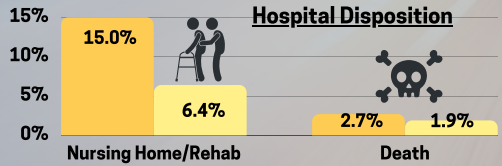
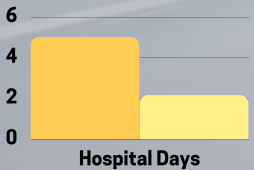


Injury Severity Score

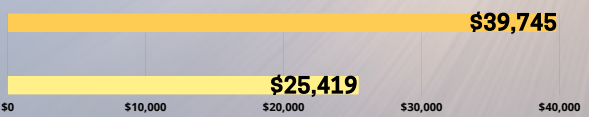


LEGEND
