

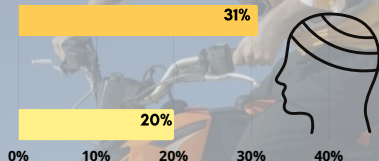

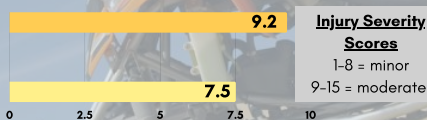


NV TRAUMA HOSPITAL INJURY OUTCOMES FOR PEDIATRIC PATIENTS (<16 YEARS)

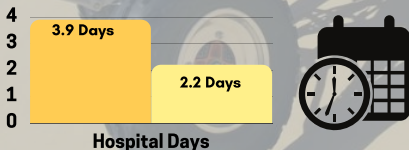
Percent of Patients with Severe Head Injury



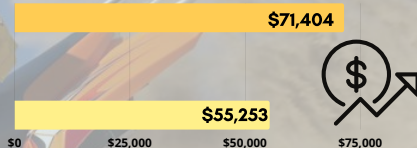
Mean Injury Severity Score (ISS)
